In addition to the above our five year objectives are:

A plan is already being implemented to integrate junior players into senior teams and will continue to develop the plan. We have formalised a partnership agreement with Peel Hall School. We plan to develop our involvement with this school, involving years 6 in 2010 and years 5 and 6 in 2011 coaching basic cricket skills. Proposed sessions to be held at BVCC. This will include assessing abilities and structuring coaching activities accordingly. In addition, we plan to re-establish the Sunday adult team on a regular basis to provide greater opportunities for junior players to participate in senior cricket and achieve the following:- Form an under 11's side by 2011; Possibly form an under 9's side by 2011. Retain and continue to develop the under 13 and under 15 sides. An number of items of our ground equipment are reaching the end of their useable life: specifically the main wicket mower & the motorised roller. We anticipate these will need to be replaced as soon as possible. We currently have 2 synthetic outdoor nets which will require substantial overhaul, including installation of improved run-up facilities. We would look to do this within the next 3 years. Certain elements of the Club House require drastic renovation, in particular, the felt roof. Early indications suggest that the cost could be around £4,500 & we are currently seeking ways of funding this project. The Toolshed roof is in an extremely poor state of repair. Estimated cost of replacement is circa £1,500, We would seek to fund repairs as soon as possible. The Club currently has 2 junior kitbags which are in a reasonable state of repair at the moment but we would anticipate that new equipment would be required in the next 5 years.
